Autism is a complex, neuro behavioural human condition. Autistic people experience debilitating frustration, anxiety, and communication barriers that lead to lifelong social isolation for themselves and often their family members too.


Did you know that when autistic adults age out of school, there are few programs or social supports available to them?

Having the support of peers and developing strong social connections can be a lifeline.

In 2012, this need became evident to a group of families in Clarington. They banded together to build a supportive network where they could gather and explore common interests through regularly scheduled sports, recreation, and social programs. That was the beginning of **Autism Home Base (AHB)**.

Today AHB serves over 200 members across Durham Region and Peterborough. Families connect at high-quality programs that are safe, non-judgemental, flexible, and adaptive to ensure participant comfort and success. These shared experiences are the foundation for lifelong peer supports. Funds raised today will help support these opportunities.

## Start your adventure!

### Directions:

- Turn left (east) onto Church Street from Autism Home Base
- Right onto Liberty Street North/Durham Regional Road 14
- Left onto King Street (HWY 2)
- Right onto Simpson Ave (at the lights by Metro)
- Make a sharp left into Visual Arts Centre of Clarington

### Checkpoint 1: VISUAL ARTS CENTRE (VAC)

**Opens: 9:30 a.m.**

**Closes: 12:30 p.m.**

**Activity:** Create a Thaumatrope  
*10 points if it works*



Restrooms Available

### from the VAC

- Left from the VAC onto Simpson
- Right on Baseline Rd.
- Left on Liberty St. South/Durham Regional Road 14
- Go under the 401, turn left on Lake Road
- Left into the Joey's World parking lot

**\*entrance is located at the back of the Joey's World building**

### Checkpoint 2: Stoick Axe Throwing

**Opens: 9:45 a.m. Closes: 12:30 p.m.**

**Activity:** Choose two people (16+) per vehicle to throw an axe - waiver must be completed before arrival

*10 points for hitting the target; 20 points for bullseye*

*Only one (highest) score per vehicle counts*

### from Stoick

- Left back onto Lake Rd to head east
- Left onto Lambs Rd/South Service Rd
- Left onto Bennett Rd
- Right onto Durham Regional Hwy 2
- Left onto Darlington Clarke Townline/Durham Regional Rd 42
- Right into driveway

### Checkpoint 3: Algoma Orchards

**Opens: 10:00 a.m. Closes: 1:30 p.m.**

**Activity:** Apple Bowling

*10 points if anyone in your vehicle gets a bullseye*



## From Algoma

- Left out of the driveway and left (East) at the stop sign back onto Hwy 2 for about 3 km
- Left on Golf Course Road for about 1 km
- Newcastle Disc Golf will be on your right, enter main gate (Newcastle Golf Club) and look for Disc Shack at east corner of parking lot

### Checkpoint 4: Newcastle Disc Golf

**Opens: 10:15 a.m. Closes: 2:30 p.m.**



**Activity:** Disc Toss

*10 points if anyone in your vehicle lands the disc in the basket*

## From Disc Golf

- Right on Golf Course Road (heading North)
- Left at Concession 3 (the first cross street)
- Continue west 3.3 km, straight through the stop sign to merge onto the 115 North
- Take 115 North approx 11 km to Concession Rd 8 exit
- Take exit to Concession Rd. 8. Turn right and continue for 3 km - The Hive is on the right

### Checkpoint 5: The Hive Centre and Stay

**Opens: 10:30 a.m. Closes: 2:30 p.m.**



**Activity:** Fire Ceremony and Tea sampling

*10 points for naming one ingredient in tea you sampled*

## From the Hive

- Right back onto Concession 8
- Turn right onto Mosport Road (\*It's only 700 metres from the Hive) and continue north for 4 km
- Left at Concession 10
- Continue west to Main Gate Entrance with our Rally sign

## Checkpoint 6: Canadian Tire Motorsport Park

**Opens: 11:00 a.m. Closes: 3:00 p.m.**

**Activity:** Driving obstacle course

*20 points for clearing ALL pylons (Lose 5 points for every pylon you knock down)*

## From Mosport

- Turn left (west) on Concession Road 10
- Left on Durham Regional Road 20
- Left on Liberty Street North
- Turn right onto Liberty Street North/Concession Rd 7
- Slight left - stay on Liberty
- Archibald's will be on your left

## Checkpoint 7: Archibald's Estate Winery

**Opens: 10:00 a.m. Closes: 3:00 p.m.**



Restrooms Available



**Activity:** Sample a hard or soft cider, learn a bit about wine  
*10 points for telling us the year the orchards were first planted*



## From Archibalds

- Turn Left (south) onto Liberty for 600 metres to Concession 6 (Flashing yellow light overhead)
- Right on Concession 6 for 8 km
- Turn right onto Enfield/Zion Rd/Durham Regional Road 34
- Knox Farms is on your right - you will see the barn

## Checkpoint 8: Knox Farm

**Opens: 11:00 a.m. Closes: 3:30 p.m.**

**Activity:** Tour the barn and visit the animals

*15 points for naming 3 animals that you saw in the barn - fill in the blanks on your scorecard, we'll tally it back at the hub*

## From Knox

- Turn left (south) onto Enfield/Zion Rd/Durham Regional Road 34 (2.6 km)
- Turn left onto Taunton Road/Durham Regional Rd 4
- Turn right on Courtice Road/Durham Regional Rd 34 for 8.9 km
- Continue south under 401, Courtice turns into Energy Road - OPG will be on your right (parking lot on east side of building)

## Checkpoint 9: Ontario Power Generation

**Opens: 11:30 a.m. Closes: 3:00 p.m.**

**Activity:** Trivia question

*10 points for getting the OPG Trivia Question correct*
